



STEP 1

Receive a bag decorated by St. Paul's VBS and Sunday School kids. Bags can be obtained at the Bags of Hope display outside of the sanctuary. All bags will contain a seed packet, "about me" note & a Bible story boardbook.

STEP 2

Fill your bag - suggested items:

- White school socks
- Flip flops
- Cloth doll
- Stickers
- Band aids
- Book - paperback easy reader
- Balls - tennis ball size or smaller
- Cars and vehicles - matchbox size
- Jump ropes
- Stuffed animals - small - not beany babies as they are heavy
- Handmade or store bought bracelets, headbands and necklaces
- Puzzles in small containers
- Washcloth and small soap in plastic holder
- Toothbrush and plastic holder, small toothpaste
- School supplies - pencil, eraser, sharpener, scissors, pen
- Plastic animals
- Crayons (small box) and coloring books (not activity ones)
