PURCHASE OF SANITATION EQUIPMENT

Pastor Greg Milinovich and Pastor Becky McGee made the decision to purchase the following sanitation equipment to prepare for reopening our building when it is possible to do so: sanitation stations for key spots; wall units for touchless hand sanitizer; several cases of sanitizer; and several boxes of masks. The total cost was approximately \$2,500. Because this was an unbudgeted amount, the pastors asked Church Council if it would agree to using a portion of its disbursement from the Endowment Fund to cover the expense.

D. Flick called for a motion and a second. J. Basiago moved that Church Council authorize the disbursement of \$2500 from the Endowment Fund disbursement to cover the cost of sanitation equipment needed to reopen the church in the near future. S. Bonsall seconded. A vote was taken on the motion; the motion passed unanimously.
